Second Reading of An Ordinance to Approve New Speed Limits, Title 6, Chapter 6-1, Article 7, of the San Leandro Municipal Code, Establishing Prima Facie Speed Limits of 25, 30, 35, and 40 Miles Per Hour on Various Street Segments Citywide

### SUMMARY

On June 17, 2024, the City Council voted 6-0-1 (Councilmember Ballew Absent) to establish lower prima facie speed limits in the City of San Leandro Municipal Code. A second reading is required to adopt Ordinance No. 2024-009, which would become effective 30 days later.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt an ordinance establishing the posted speed limits on various street segments Citywide based upon recent engineering and traffic surveys, and the requirements of the San Leandro Municipal Code and the CVC.
