RESOLUTION of the City of San Leandro City Council to Approve the City of San Leandro Human Services Commission’s Recommendations for the Community Assistance Program (CAP) Grants for Fiscal Year 2019-20 and to Approve Additional Appropriations of \$28,355 from the General Fund Unrestricted Reserves to Operating Account 010-61-014-8513 to restore the CAP to Full Funding of \$150,000.
