RESOLUTION Accepting the Engineer's Report for Fiscal Year 2016-17 for the Heron Bay Maintenance Assessment District, Assessment District No. 96-3 (Provides Funding for the On-Going Maintenance of Certain Public Facilities Constructed as part of the Heron Bay Development)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Leandro, pursuant to the provisions of the San Leandro Municipal Code, §2-5-100 et seq. did order the Engineer, Wildan Financial Services, to prepare and file a report in accordance with the Code in connection with the proposed levy and collection of assessments for the district known and designated as the Heron Bay Maintenance Assessment District (Assessment District No. 96-3) for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer prepared and filed with the City Clerk of the City of San Leandro, and the City Clerk presented to the City Council such report entitled "Engineer's Report, Heron Bay Maintenance Assessment District, Assessment District No. 96-3, Fiscal Year 2016/2017" (hereafter referred to as the "Report", attached hereto and made a part hereof); and
