RESOLUTION of the City of San Leandro City Council to Approve a Consulting Services Agreement with TJKM Transportation Consultants for the Design of the East 14th Street/144th Avenue and East 14th Street/Joaquin Avenue Signal Projects in the Amount of \$72,612 and Authorizing the City Manager to Negotiate and Execute Individual Contract Amendments up to 10% (\$7,261) and Cumulative Amendments up to a Maximum of 25% (\$18,153)

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded 2016-17 Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant funds to install a High-intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) signal at the East 14<sup>th</sup> Street at 144<sup>th</sup> Avenue intersection and a Scramble Pedestrian Signal Phase to the existing signal at the East 14<sup>th</sup> Street and Joaquin Avenue intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, proposals were sought from consultants who specialize in design of traffic signals; and

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing proposals from four consultants, staff recommends that TJKM Transportation Consultants should be retained for design services for these traffic signals in the amount of \$72,612; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and approve Individual Contract Amendments up to 10% (\$7,261) and Cumulative Amendments up to Maximum of 25% (\$18,153); and

**WHEREAS**, a Consulting Services Agreement for TJKM Transportation Consultants, a copy of which is attached, is presented to this City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is familiar with the contents of the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager recommends approval of said agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does **RESOLVE** as follows:

- That said agreement is hereby approved and execution by the City Manager is hereby authorized; and
- That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to negotiate and approve individual contract amendments up to 10% (\$7,261) and cumulative amendments up to a maximum of 25% (\$18,153).
