RESOLUTION of the City of San Leandro City Council to Approve a Reduction in the Number of Vehicle Travel Lanes from Three to Two and Installation of a Class IV Bicycle Lane on Fairmont Drive from Hesperian Boulevard to East 14th Street (*Authorizes repurposing one travel lane in each direction on Fairmont Drive for use as a class IV bicycle lane*)

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering report evaluating the impact of a reduction in the number of travel lanes is presented to this City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is familiar with the contents thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends approval of a reduction in travel lanes from three to two and installation of Class IV Bicycle Lanes on Fairmont Drive from Hesperian Boulevard to East 14th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does RESOLVE as follows:

That Fairmont Drive from Hesperian Boulevard to East 14th Street shall be restriped such that there are two vehicle travel lanes and one class IV bicycle lane in each direction.
