RESOLUTION of the City of San Leandro City Council Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Consulting Services Agreement with OIR Group for Internal Affairs Investigation Services, Training Review Report, and Presentation of Police Oversight Models, in an Amount Not to Exceed \$55,000

WHEREAS, the OIR Group submitted a proposal to the City of San Leandro ("City") to provide consulting services for internal affairs investigation services, a training review report, and a presentation to the City Council on police oversight models; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize the above-referenced consulting services agreement with OIR Group based upon their distinct subject matter expertise and positive track record supporting similar work for other public agencies in California; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is familiar with the contents of the proposed consulting services agreement and scope of work, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does RESOLVE as follows:

That the City Council approves, and the City Manager is authorized to execute a Consulting Services Agreement with OIR Group in an amount not to exceed \$55,000 using existing General Fund appropriations from the adopted FY 2020-2021 City budget.
