



MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

of City Council action taken May 18, 2026





CHARTER SECTION 305(h)

“The Mayor shall ... possess the authority to suspend implementation of any action taken by the Council by filing with the City Clerk, within three days after such Council action, a notice of suspension thereof. Such suspension shall constitute a motion for reconsideration of the action taken, to be voted upon by the Council at its next regular meeting.”



CITY COUNCIL ACTION FROM MAY 18, 2026

The City Council voted to accept an urgency referral to consider a resolution at a City Council meeting in July that would reaffirm the City Council's intent regarding rehabilitation of Lake Chabot Road.

The motion **CARRIED** with **5 yes votes** (J. Aguilar, V. Aguilar, Simon, Viveros-Walton, González) and **2 no votes** (Boldt, Bowen).

RECOMMENDED ACTION

1. Vote on the Mayor's Motion for Reconsideration; and
2. If the Motion for Reconsideration passes, the City Council may then reconsider the original action taken on May 18, 2026.
