RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$100,000 IN DONATION FUNDS FROM THE ROTARY CLUB OF SAN LEANDRO TO SUPPORT THE INSTALLATION OF A NEW FITNESS COURT AT MARINA PARK AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY RELATED TO THE DONATION

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of San Leandro is a local chapter of Rotary International, a global service organization dedicated to improving communities through volunteerism and leadership; and

WHEREAS, the Club's purpose is to unite local leaders, professionals, and residents in carrying out service projects that benefit the San Leandro community and support broader humanitarian initiatives through community improvement, youth development, education, public health, and related service activities; and

WHEREAS, the Club has supported the City and community through involvement in numerous park renovation projects, beautification projects and community cleanups; and

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of San Leandro, founded in 1926, is celebrating its 100th anniversary of service to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of San Leandro has committed to making a \$100,000 donation to the City to support the installation of a National Fitness Campaign fitness court at Marina Park, including commemorative elements such as a monument and plaque recognizing the Club's 100th anniversary; and

WHEREAS, the donation will offset project costs and enhance public recreational infrastructure consistent with the City's goals related to health, wellness, and quality of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does **RESOLVE** as follows:

1. Acceptance and Appropriation of Funds. That the City Council hereby accepts the donation from the Rotary Club of San Leandro in the amount of \$100,000 and appropriates said funds into the Park Development Fee Fund Undesignated Fund Balance to support the installation of a fitness court and related commemorative improvements at Marina Park; and
2. That the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary related to the donation.
