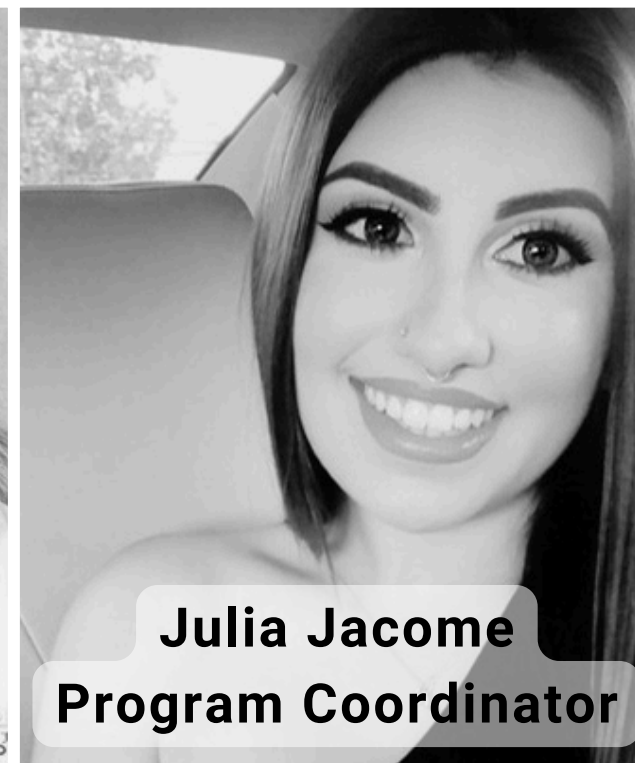

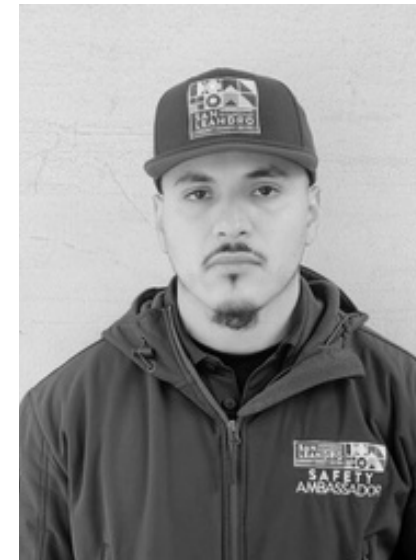

BENEFIT DISTRICT BASICS

Established in 2013, requires renewal in 2028 by a vote of the property owners.

Administered by San Leandro Improvement Association (SLIA), a 501c3 not-for-profit organization.

The SLIA Board is comprised primarily of property owners or their designees and 1/3 or fewer “At-Large” members.

Assessments determined by physical measurements of property, not value.

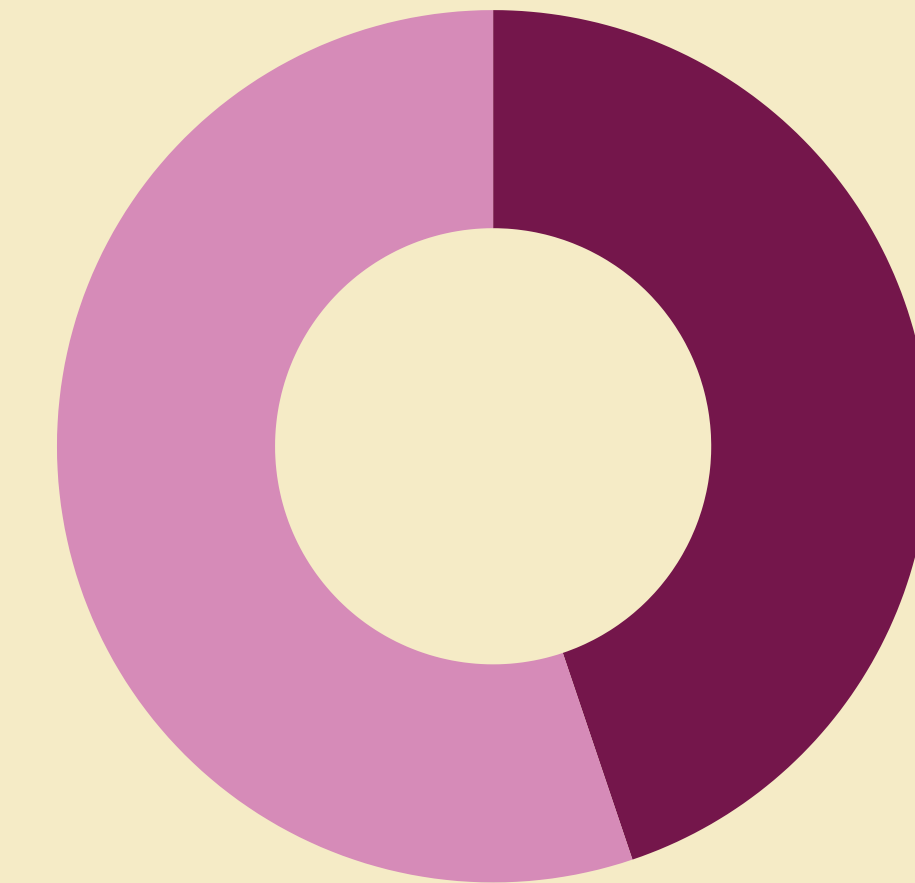
Single-family residences do not receive services and are not assessed.



2025 FINANCIALS

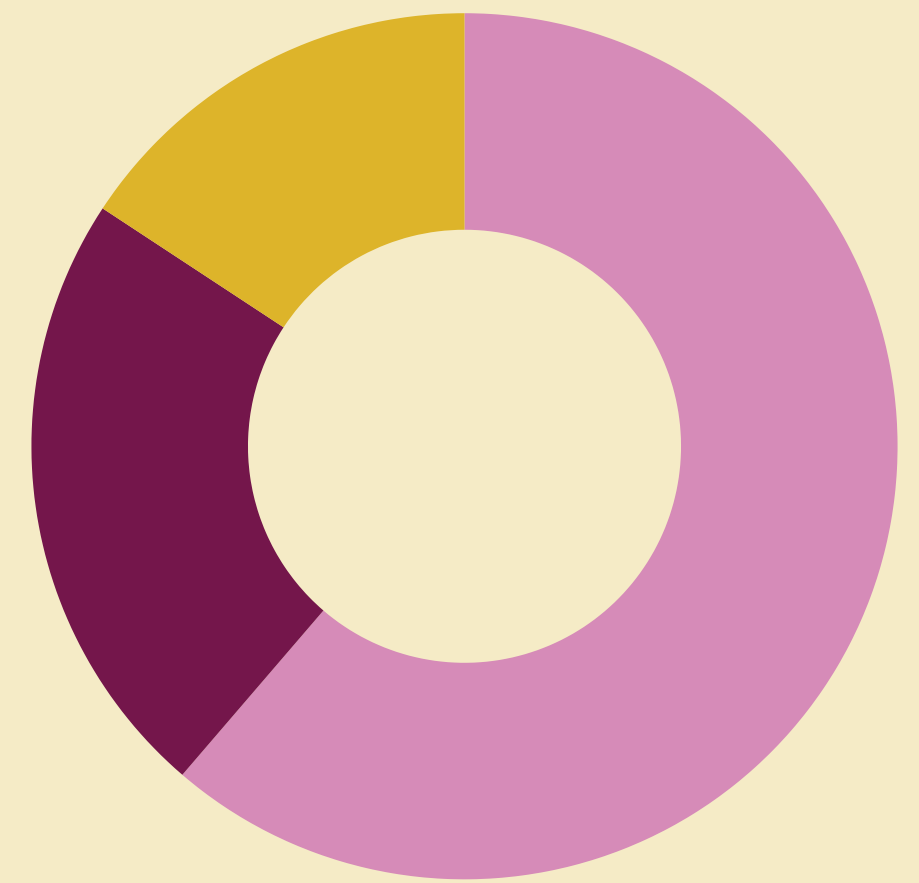
Flat grant funding for the Safety Ambassador program and necessary capital expenditures resulted in an operating deficit for the first time in five years. Reserves built up over the past several years have absorbed the deficit, but programmatic cuts will be required if funding is not fully restored.

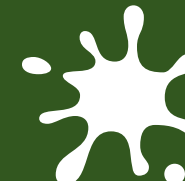

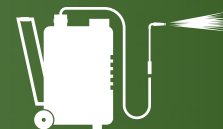

MOSAIC DAMAGE

On December 19, 2025, a commercial crashed into the mosaic planter at the intersection of E 14th at Davis St.

Damages occurred to the planter (approx. \$6,500) and the International House of Pancakes (IHOP) roof.

This intersection has had a history of vehicle crashes and resulting property damages. Remedies to prevent further damages and serious injury to pedestrians include hardscaping.
